#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Hartley 16 – The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- 1.3 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to all boats of the Hartley 16 that comply with the class rules and whose owner(s) are current financial members of the H16 Class Association.

- 3.3 Late entries, accompanied by the contest entry fee plus the late entry fee may be accepted at the race committee's discretion until ~~1500 hours Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> March~~ 1600hrs Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2022.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of an affiliated club recognized by the entrant and crew member's national authority.

## 5 COVID VACINATION MANDATE

- 5.1. The running and organisation of this event will be subject to the Coronavirus requirements at the time.
- 5.2. In accordance with the Government's Covid Protection Framework (traffic light system) all attendees, sailors, officials, supporters, and volunteers aged 12 years 3 months and over, attending the ~~Manukau Yacht & Motor Boat Club events or venues~~, New Plymouth Yacht Club will be required to provide a My Vaccine Pass for verification.

## 7 MEASUREMENTS

- 7.1 At the discretion of the Hartley 16 committee, boats will be weighed and other measurements taken to ensure boats meet class rules and safety regulations. Any sails not previously signed will also be measured.
- 7.2 A safety declaration is to be completed at registration. NB: a safety check may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

**8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available ~~at registration on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2022 at the Manukau Yacht and Motor Boat Club~~. Online at npyc.co.nz from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022

**9 VENUE & RACING AREA**

The venue is the ~~Manukau Yacht and Motor Boat Club~~ New Plymouth Yacht Club. The sailing area is on the waters off Port Taranaki ~~the Manukau harbor off the Mangere Bridge shoreline~~. See addendum A & B.

**10 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward.

**11 PENALTY SYSTEM**

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

**12 SCORING**

Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.  
When from 6 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score

**13 LAUNCHING**

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from ~~boat ramps adjacent to the Manukau Yacht and Motor Boat Club~~. Boat ramp at Lee Breakwater or beach in front of the club

**14 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

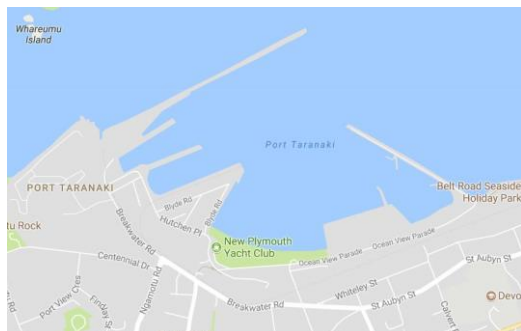

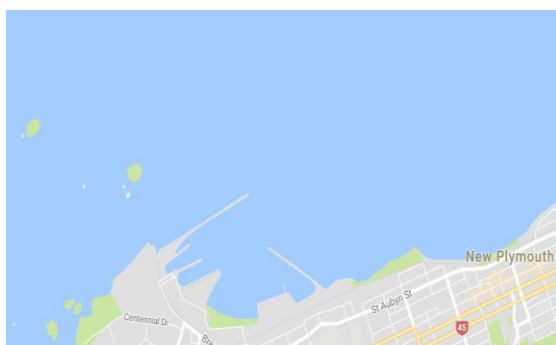
