SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Addendum A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing (page 146 RRS 2021-2024).

RULES

- **SSI 1** The Yachting New Zealand Prescriptions 2021-24 and the Yachting New Zealand Standard Safety Regulations Part1 shall apply.
- **SSI 2** Rule 42 Propulsion will be changed as permitted by Rule C.1.1.1 of the 420 Class rules.
- SSI 3 Appendix T will apply.
- **SSI 4** Appendix P will apply.

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2)

SSI 5 The race office is located at Naval Point Club Lyttelton (NPCL).

The official notice board is located at NPCL.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

- **SSI 6** Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located on the eastern end of the NPCL clubhouse.
- **SSI 7** When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.
- **SSI 8** [DP] Flag D with one sound means 'Boats shall not leave the shore until this signal is made. The warning signal will not be made before the scheduled time or less than 30 minutes after flag D is displayed.'

SCHEDULE OF RACES AND CLASS FLAGS (SI 5 & 6)

SSI 9 The Class flag will be the class insignia on a white background.

SSI 11 On Sunday 10th of March no warning signal will be made after 1500 hrs.

COURSES (SI 7)

- **SSI 12** The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Addendum A.
- **SSI 13** In the event that a gate mark is missing and has not been replaced with an object displaying flag M, the remaining mark shall be rounded to port.

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 14 The description of the marks is in the table in Addendum A.

THE START (SI 9)

- **SSI 15** To alert boats that a race will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound signal at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.
- **SSI 16** A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1and 5.2.

TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.

PENALTY SYSTEM

SSI 18 RRS P2.2 and P2.3 are deleted and RRS P2.1 is amended to "When a boat is penalised under RRS P1 her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty under RRS 44.2. If she fails to take the penalty, she shall be disqualified without a hearing."

CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN

SSI 19 [DP] Competitors shall individually check-out before racing by personally signing check out sheets located at NPCL.


Competitors shall individually check-in immediately on returning to shore after racing by personally signing check-in sheets located at NPCL.

SUPPORT VESSELS

SSI 20 All official and support vessels shall always have an engine safety cut out switch (kill cord) attached to the driver while the engine is running, unless prior written exemption has been provided by the Organising Authority.



Course Illustration — Trapezoid with signal boat for start and finish.


