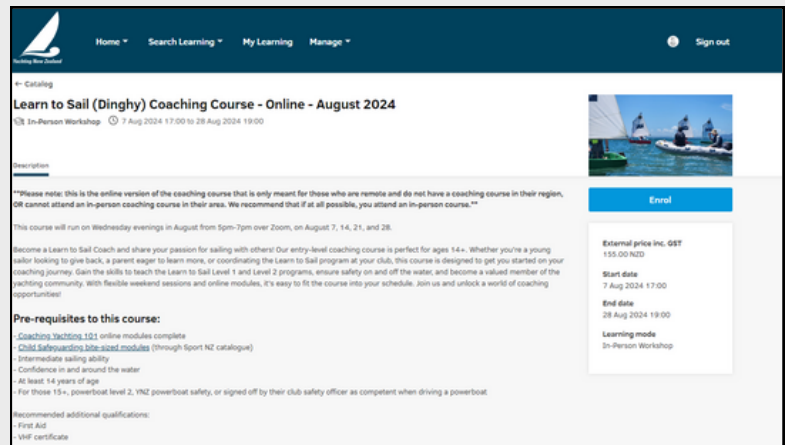
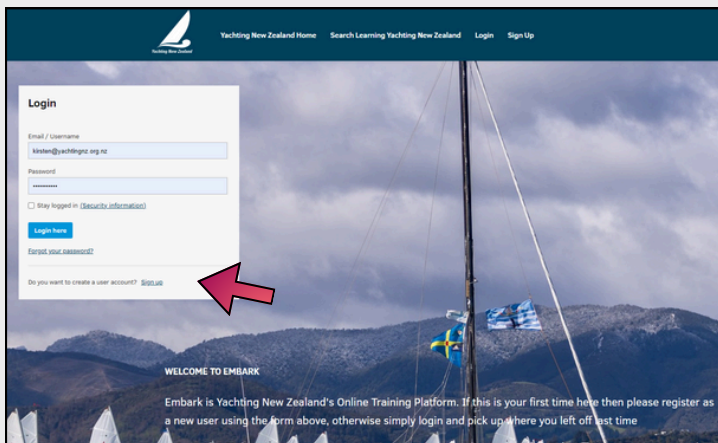


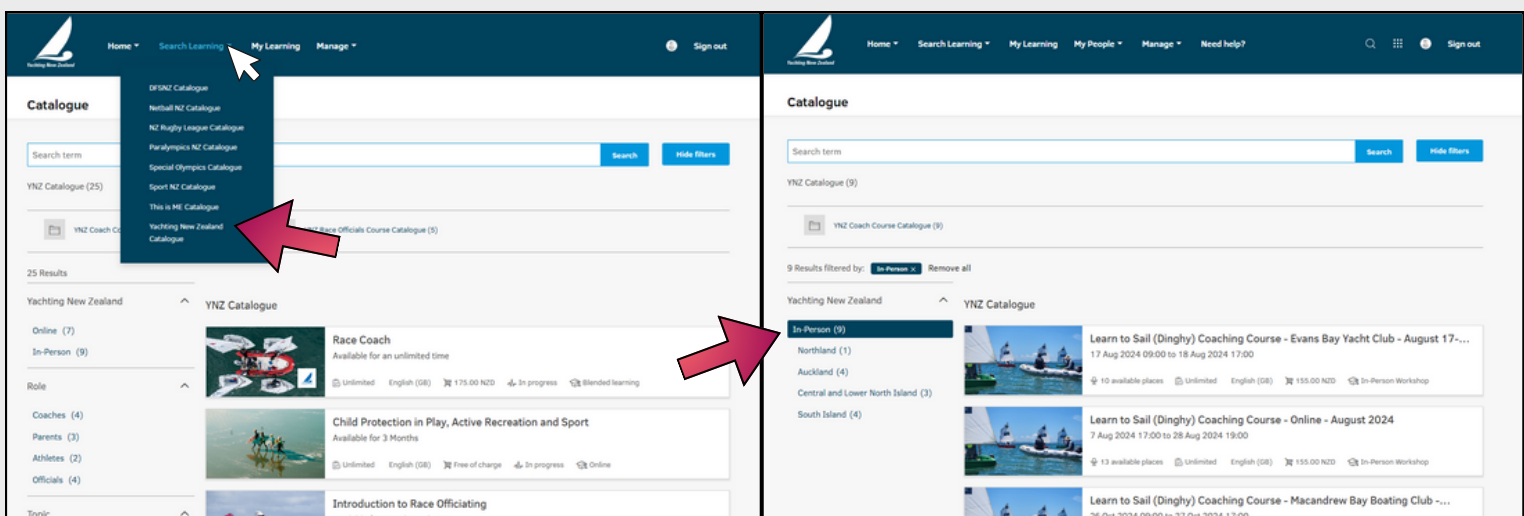
Embark - a guide to Yachting New Zealand's online learning platform

Getting Started



- You can access [Embark](https://yachtingnz.org.nz) through the Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) website yachtingnz.org.nz by going to the [course schedule](#) page. Click on any of the links or the course you want to sign up for.
- If you haven't used our online learning platform before you will **need to create a new user account**.
- If you have a login for the YNZ website, it **WILL NOT** work on Embark - however we recommend you use the same one to make it easier to remember.
